- Hotel sleeping rooms rates are negotiated and significantly lower priced than the groups can negotiate due to our relationship with the national chains, and bulk of sleeping rooms we block each year
- Globetrotter is able to negotiate special concessions from the hotel, i.e. comp rooms, upgrades, free meeting space, discounted parking, etc. - based on the needs of the event
- Rental fees are greatly reduced on meeting space or totally eliminated based on Food & Beverage
- Globetrotter maintains rooming lists and reports for the hotel and/or group to ensure that the group attendees are properly reserved and not walked to another hotel due to the hotel overbooking. This also ensures that if there is sleeping room attrition all rooms are correctly applied and credited to the Master Account to greatly reduce any penalty.
